DETAILS:

GEF is an independent, non-profit organization dedicated to supporting public education in Greene County. Our mission is to further enrich the educational experience for the children and educators of Greene County Schools.

We are pleased to have this opportunity to offer one \$1,000 scholarships this year to deserving high school seniors.

GEF'S Outreach theme for 2012-2013 academic school is: Motivation in Learning. Recipients of this years GEF scholarships will need to demonstrate strong leadership abilities and accomplishments as a leader in and out of the classroom.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

All scholarship applicants must complete the following:

- Submit an official GEF application form.
- Include a copy of most recent student transcript.
- Plan to enroll in secondary education at a college or trade school of your choice.
- Include two letters of recommendation. (1 Teacher/ 1-Non Teacher)
- Include a description of financial situation:
 - Describe your financial need or cost of first year of schooling.
 - List any financial aid, grants, scholarship, etc., you are currently receiving or will receive during next school year.
- Include up to a two-page (12 pt) typewritten statement of the following:
 - Education objectives (both short- and long-term).
 - Work history and/or voluntary experiences.
 - Extra-curricular activities involved in during high school education.
 - Any honors or awards received while in high school.
 - Description of course(s), experience, projects, athletic teams, or community roles, in which leadership was an important component and how you demonstrated leadership through those opportunities.

The deadline for submitting applications is 4:30 p.m. on April 20, 2012.

REVIEW:

Judging is subject to a scholarship evaluation committee consisting of Executive Members of the GEF Board and an Education Liaison. Recipients of the scholarship awards will be based on information provided in the application packet. The committee members will not know the names of the applicants during the judging process. Applicants will be evaluated using a point system based on the items shown at the right of the application. Applications that do not contain all requested information will not be considered.

AWARDS:

Scholarship award recipients will be announced at the Senior Award ceremony in May. Checks will be disbursed once the student begins the first semester at his/her selected college or university and will be paid directly to the school.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be U.S. citizens and a 2013 graduate of William Monroe High School.
